Home of the family of the businessman and financier Axel Wenner-Gren. The parents acquired the cabinet from Svenskt Tenn in c. 1941, shortly after their marriage.

Documents in the Svenskt Tenn Archive show: 'Cabinet with copper plate - Model no. 1140. Oak strips around each copper plate.' 'Buffon's natural history, the 'Apskåpet (Monkey Cabinet)'.

Most likely a special commissioned piece.
